UF Health North is the only comprehensive medical complex in North Jacksonville. In addition to a 92bed hospital and full-service emergency room, the campus includes an outpatient surgery center and more than 30 specialty services offered by top University of Florida and community physicians. In early 2022, a groundbreaking was held for the latest expansion at UF Health North, a new bed tower, which will feature 124 patient rooms and two dedicated floors for rehabilitation therapy services.


